The type of anxiety that requires treatment is called generalized anxiety disorder (GAD). Although there are more than twenty benzodiazepine derivatives, only certain ones have been approved to treat anxiety (eg, alprazolam, clonazepam, diazepam, and lorazepam), sleeplessness (insomnia) (eg, estazolam, flurazepam, quazepam, temazepam and triazolam), or panic ...

Together these categories of psychoactive compounds or interventions may be referred to as anxiotropic compounds or agents.
